






Land Sale Performance

Land Transfer / Revenue







Revenue breakdown















Operating Results – Gross Margin




Vietnam: Strong FDI Momentum


Total registered foreign direct investment (FDI) for 9M-2017 was USD 25.5 billion

Increasing numbers of FDIs are turning their interest towards the northern part of Vietnam with big electronic manufacturers leading the marketing










Shareholding Structure


