



VIETNAM GDP 1Q'2022









FOREIGN DIRECT INVESTMENT (FDI) JAN – APR 2022




FDI RECORD (\$bn) JAN-APR & YEARLY






FOREIGN DIRECT INVESTMENT JAN - APR 2022 (1)




With 01 major project, Denmark take over 3rd ranking while Singapore maintain as biggest investors in Vietnam











- Rental revenue marginally dropped according to the sales of RBFs since 4Q2021







REVENUE BREAKDOWN BY BUSINESS TYPE


